Kym Scott - Conductor

Kym Scott graduated from the Queensland Conservatorium of Music in 1997 after completing a Bachelor of Music (Instrumental). During this time she began her choral conducting studies with Dr John Nickson. Over the past 11 years, Kym has participated in numerous Summer Schools, seminars and national workshops in Brisbane, Sydney, Newcastle, Hobart, Port Macquarie and Wellington. In 2010 she completed a Master of Music degree at the University of Queensland and in August, 2011 will begin a Doctor of Musical Arts degree at the University of Southern California, USA.

Kym has conducted choirs with members aged from 8 to 80 years of age both at schools and in the wider community. She is also an accomplished accompanist. Kym is the musical director/conductor of community choirs 'Southern Cross Voices' and 'Chordiality' and school choirs, 'Grammar Voices' and 'Grammar Chorus' at the Brisbane Girls Grammar School where she also teaches voice.

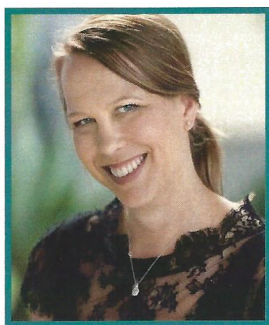
